
### **POPULATION TRENDS**


The population of Sitka is consistent with that of southeast Alaska. The population increased from 2011 until 2014 and has decreased to below the 2011 starting point. From the 2014 high, Southeast Alaska has lost 1,603 or -2.15% of the people. Sitka has seen a similar decline from 9,085 people in 2014 to 8,748 people in 2017. That is a change of 337 people for the city, or -3.71% of the population.



### SCHOOL ENROLLMENT TRENDS


Sitka public school enrollment mirrors this trend. Public school enrollment peaked in 2013 with 1,395 students. Looking at the same years of 2014-2017 the public school enrollment dropped by 91 students or -6.62%. The preliminary number from the Sitka School District is 1,207 for 2018. This is an additional drop of 77 students which is a -5.99% decrease in one year. (Source: AK Dept. of Education and Sitka School District)






#### **UTILITY TRENDS**

Even with the population decline the number of electrical customers has increased. The low on this chart was in 2011 with 1,757 residential customers. In 2017 this number increased to 3,242 customers. Commercial customers increased from 430 to 702 and harbor customers increased from 261 to 693. (*Source: City of Sitka CAFR*)





#### SALES TAX TRENDS

Sales tax receipts have also increased. In 2011 the number of receipts was 8,503,838 and in 2017 it was 10,817,808. That is an increase of over 2.3 million or 27.21% in 7 years. (Source: City of Sitka CAFR.)
