HOUSING TRENDS

This chart shows the total homes on the market as of September 13, 2018. Currently there are 42 houses listed on the MLS including homes for sale by owner. Home prices range from \$37,000 to \$2.4 million. The lowest priced house is a 2 bedroom 1 bathroom mobile home built in 1967, it does



not include land. The average list price of a home in Sitka is \$513,750. The lowest price range for a house with land is between \$300,000 and \$399,000. Over one quarter of the houses listed are in this range. Anything less expensive than \$300,000 is a condo or manufactured home. Included in the condo section is one new construction in the Sitka Community Land Trust. Please note, these properties are all connected to the road system in Sitka. Island properties are not included. (Source: Davis Realty, Baranof Realty, Realtor.com, and Zillow.com)

According to Davis Realty and Baranof Realty the average sales price of homes from 2009 through 2016 is \$337,500. The top year was 2016 with an average of just over \$400,000 and the lowest year was 2009 with a little over \$260,000 average.

LAND TRENDS

The average cost for a parcel of land for sale in Sitka is \$147,111. If the one property for \$410,000 is not included, the average price drops to \$114,250. Currently there are 9 parcels listed on the MLS including 2 for sale by owner. Prices range from \$50,000 to \$410,000. As with the homes for sale, any property that is not connected by road is not included in this chart. (Source: Davis Realty, Baranof Realty, Realtor.com, and Zillow.com)



PROPERTY SOLD

These charts show the past 11 years of homes, new dwelling units, and vacant lots sold. The number of total homes sold has more than doubled since 2015. In 2015 the total number of homes sold was 114. This number increased to 211 in 2016 and increased again in 2017 to 271.
